It takes approx 12 mins to walk or 4 mins to cycle from this distance (1km)

It takes approximately 24 minutes to walk or 8 minutes to cycle from this distance (2km)

It takes approximately 36 minutes to walk or 12 minutes to cycle from this distance (3km)

It takes approximately 48 minutes to walk or 16 minutes to cycle from this distance (4km)

It takes approximately 60 minutes to walk or 20 minutes to cycle from this distance (5km)

It takes approximately 72 minutes to walk or 24 minutes to cycle from this distance (6km)

Each grid square on this map represents half a kilometre.

1 km = 1000 metres

1 mile = 1609 metres

1 hour = 60 minutes

1 minute = 60 seconds
